AHADITH

- 1) “Avoid falling under suspicion. For suspicion does the worst damage. Do not inquire into the lives of others. Do not pry. Do not exaggerate what others say. Bear each other no malice, and do not hurt each other’s interests. And, by being brothers to each other become the servants of God.”
- 2) “One who says his prayers (salah) with great propriety when he is in the presence of others, but does so without proper reverence when he is alone, is committing an act of contempt for his Lord.”
- 3) “According to Anas Ibn Malik, when God’s Messenger (s.a.w) said, “Help your brother, irrespective of whether he is the oppressor or the oppressed,” a man said, “O Messenger of God, I can help the oppressed, but how can I help the oppressor?” The Prophet (s.aw.) replied, “Stop him from committing an act of oppression. That in itself is a form of help.”
